Please would you and your church stand with us in prayer for the people in Ukraine affected by the collapse of the Kakhovka dam in Southern Ukraine. Samaritan's Purse are sending out supplies through local churches and teams to bring assistance to those affected

- We plead for comfort over all those affected by extensive flooding occurring in Southern Ukraine. Lord, bring your peace that surpasses our human understanding to the thousands that have been displaced. We also ask that you would bring comfort and relief to those whose cities and homes that have been flooded.
