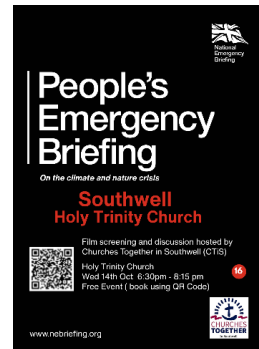
People's Emergency Briefing: Wednesday 14 October

Deep Peace | Dave's Living Hope Story

People have asked us to share Dave's testimony. We hope to have the full video available soon, but for now you can watch this short video from the Diocese.

"I was overwhelmed with love and joy — it was bursting out of me."

For years, Dave had rejected the idea of faith and God. As a police officer, the pressures of the job gradually took their toll, and he struggled with anxiety and PTSD for many years. Then, last year, some family friends invited him to Alpha at his wife's church — and, to everyone's surprise, Dave said yes.

During one of the sessions, his friends offered to pray for him. In that moment, something changed. Dave describes being overwhelmed by a deep sense of peace, love and joy. Since then, he says he has experienced healing from his PTSD and has seen his life transformed. Sometimes, all it takes is an invitation — and being willing to say yes to something you never thought you would.
