## MISSION NEWS

UCI Lira, Uganda

This quarter we sent £910 to UCI, which gave them 4 million shillings. Sam Omara sent this message to the church:

*"In regards to the donation, Simon [the Bursar] told me that we received 4m as you indicated and we are saving some money to buy computers for the ICT department and we intend to buy about 50 more additional computers for PD this time. Please continue to pray for us as this will require approximately 75m since the ones we had seems to be outdated." PD is the Professional Development school, which runs courses in Agriculture, Business, Medical Records and similar.*



## SMALL GROUPS

Everyone who attends Holy Trinity is important, and by being there makes a valuable contribution to our church family. All that happens between Sunday and Sunday is as important as the Sunday Services, and Small Groups play a large part in this and helps us to build our relationship with God and build community.
