KEFRAMA HIGH SCHOOL UGANDA

Last year Keframa School Build provided the funding for a girls' dormitory at KHS as well as two staff houses. We have just had a message from Monica Akidi, a pupil at the school who is sponsored through our sponsorship programme, and I would like to share some of her message:

"I have written this letter to thank you for the gift you have granted to us (the girls Dormitory). It has really helped to solve many of the girls problems thus providing security and comfort. Before it was very risky for us to move from the old site to the new site during both dawn and evening preps, but now we are secured. And there had been small space for bathing where many girls could squeeze in a small space to save time and that led to increased infections like vaginal candidiasis among others. But the new shelter that has been constructed has many rooms for us to bathe separately using showers hence promoting hygiene because there's no water flashbacks like those days when we used to bathe with buckets.

I also want to thank you so much for the computers which were brought. These has helped us so much to carry out research and do our continuous practices as well, we are aiming for better performances, I now see that there will be a lot of improvement and development academically."
