Monday 1st

Tuesday 2nd

Pray for Russia in the wake of its 'election', that voices other than Putin's will be heard in that land.

Wednesday 3rd

Pray for the loved ones of all those who died in last month's terrible attack in Moscow, for comfort and strength as they come to terms with their huge loss.

Thursday 4th

Continue to pray for an end to the war in Ukraine, and for all the displaced families across the world.

Friday 5th *Persecuted but not forgotten: Indonesia #42 on Open Doors' World Watch List

Most pressure for Christian converts in this Islamic nation takes the form of isolation, verbal abuse and ostracisation. Pray for a lessening of these measures.

Saturday 6th

Pray for renewed impetus for our Eco Church Status, that we will be committed to doing all we can to protect God's wonderful Creation.

Sunday 7th Easter 1

Risen Christ, for whom no door is locked, no entrance barred: open the door of our hearts, that we may seek the good of others and walk the joyful road of sacrifice and peace, to the praise of God the Father. Amen

Monday 8th

Pray for the work of Tearfund in Cambodia, that their programme of Church & Community Transformation will bear much fruit.

Tuesday 9th

Ask God's blessing on our link mission partners, Tim & Miranda in southern Spain; for renewed vision and energy in all they do.

Wednesday 10th

As PCC has an extra meeting tonight to follow up the vision morning with Archdeacon Tors, pray for the Holy Spirit's leading and guidance.
