Wednesday 1st

Friday 3rd *Persecuted but not forgotten – China, #17 on Open Doors' World Watch List

There are some 100 million Christians in China. Many worship in unregistered churches, knowing that at any point they could be shut down. Pray for strength and bravery.

Saturday 4th Men's Breakfast

Thank God for this bi-monthly event, and ask that today's will be energised and led by the Holy Spirit.

Sunday 5th Trinity 5

Almighty God, send down upon your Church the riches of your Spirit, and kindle in all who minister the gospel your countless gifts of grace; through Jesus Christ our Lord, Amen.

Monday 6th Small Groups

Ask God's blessing on all our small groups, many meeting this week. Pray that everyone in our fellowship will be able to be part of one and experience your love and support.

Tuesday 7th Toddlers

Thank God for the team that runs this group and pray for strength and energy as the holidays loom. Pray that we will have creative ways of engaging with the families at other times, too.

Wednesday 8th Living with Loss

Pray for Jon and the PCC as they take time to seek God's way forward for Trinity; that by his Spirit they will discern all that God is leading us into.

Sunday 12th Trinity 6

Creator God, you made us all in your image: may we discern you in all that we see, and serve you in all that we do; through Jesus Christ our Lord, Amen.

Monday 13th Our Vision

Bring to God our vision for support to grow our children, youth and families' work, that God will lead and direct every part of it.

Tuesday 14th The Morleys

Thank God for Jon, Ella and Zachy, and ask God's richest blessing on them in all they do.

Wednesday 15th Connections

Pray for more people to join the team who lead this strategic work, that our time, talents, and treasure will all be poured into it.

Thursday 16th Our Fellowship

Friday 17th *Persecuted but not forgotten – China

Pray for young believers, that God will raise up a new generation of Chinese Christians across this vast land.

Saturday 18th Fathers' Day/Kids & Families' Fun Time

Ask God for a good response to tomorrow's Kids' & Families session at 4pm, for a great time of fun, great conversations, and a sense of God's presence. Pray that those who come will catch a glimpse of our perfect Heavenly Father.

Sunday 19th Trinity 7

Generous God, you give us gifts and make them grow: though our faith is small as mustard seed, make it grow to your glory and the flourishing of your kingdom; through Jesus Christ our Lord, Amen.

Monday 20th Tearfund

Pray for Tearfund in its tireless work among the poorest on earth, that all their partners worldwide will be encouraged and blessed.

Tuesday 21st CMS

Pray for our Mission Partners Tim and Miranda in Spain, and ask for God's continued blessing, guidance and protection for them.

Wednesday 22nd NHS

Thank God for our NHS and pray for it to be adequately resourced in terms of finance and personnel. Pray for any staff known to you personally.

Thursday 23rd CPAS

Pray for the patronage team of CPAS as they appoint gospel-focused incumbents in many churches, for God's wisdom to lead this process.

Friday 24th *Persecuted but not forgotten – China

Ask God to help church leaders to navigate restrictions and surveillance, and to inspire the words of those brought before the authorities (Mark 13:11).

Saturday 25th Songs for Summer

Pray for those who will be teaching us next month from the book of Psalms, for God's word to come alive among us.

Sunday 26th Trinity 8

Your Son left the riches of heaven and became poor for your sake: when we prosper save us from pride, when we are needy save us from despair, that we may trust in you alone; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen

Monday 27th Venture & Falcon Camps

Thank God for all the summer camps which will be presenting the gospel to young people, and ask that many of them will get to know Jesus, or grow in their faith in him.

Tuesday 28th Areas of Conflict

Bring to God somewhere that is in the news today because of outright war or the threat of it.

Wednesday 29th Connections/Moments through August

Pray that this gathering will continue to be a blessing through the summer to all who come, and that God will be at work in the hearts of all them.

Thursday 30th Going

Pray for this third part of our vision – that we will find new and imaginative ways of being involved in our community, bringing Jesus' light.

Friday 31st *Persecuted but not forgotten – China

Sovereign God, equip your Chinese family with all they need to stand strong in their faith and share it with others. In the powerful name of Jesus, Amen.
